Family carers often find themselves unable to get out to do everyday tasks without a great deal of pre-arrangement. Finding a standin carer isn't easy. Levin Adult Day Club was formed 29 years ago to fulfil that need, and continues to do so today.

Every Monday and Wednesday the Club operates out of the Levin Baptist Church Hall in Rugby Street, Levin from 9.30am until 3.00pm. Carers can leave those they care for in a safe and social environment.

The Centre's daily programme is varied and includes things such as bowls, cards, board games, quizzes and visiting entertainers. Volunteers and staff are on hand when needed, for example reading for the print disabled. The centre always welcomes new volunteers.

All areas of the centre are wheelchair-friendly with handrails, ramps and wide doorways for ease of access. Morning tea, a two-course lunch and afternoon tea are made and served on the premises.

Transport to the Club can be provided locally for those who need it, and for a small charge guests can be picked up from Shannon and Foxton. Funding for eligible guests is provided by Mid Central Health through Support Links. Those who do meet the Support Links criteria can pay a small daily fee.
