In March last year the Kapiti and Horowhenua branch was born. Since then the Kaibosh team of volunteers have rescued 35,891 kg of food in Kapiti and Horowhenua, have provided the equivalent of 102,546 meals to local people in need and reduced carbon emissions by 12,956 kg.

Food is only accepted from licensed food outlets and professionally catered events, not from individual homes. Kaibosh works to the highest food safety standards. Food must not be expired, open, old or in anyway used or contaminated.
