The service began in 2008 with two return journeys a day for 38 passengers a month. Now four passenger vans with wheelchair lifts, make five weekday return trips and one on a Saturday.

The shuttle departs from Levin's Horowhenua Health Care Centre and stops for passengers in Levin, Shannon, Foxton and Tokomaru. This enables up to 10,000 local passengers a year to access health care

in Palmerston North. Patients being discharged from hospital can also be collected.

A co-ordinator is employed to handle the logistics of such a busy schedule.

For every journey the shuttle is manned by a volunteer driver and support person. Without these wonderful people, the service could not exist.

New volunteers are always needed. Applications are welcome from people with the ability to cover any rostered return trips.



Shuttle service. A round trip is approximately four hours. Drivers will need a full license.

Operating as a Charitable Trust, donations are vital in maintaining and upgrading the shuttle vans. There are envelopes and donation boxes on all of the shuttles.
