The expansion will see amenities such as much improved toilet facilities, a kitchen and meeting area. Eventually the original 42m² workshop will be replaced by one covering 170m².

The Shed was started with an aim to provide a place for men to meet for companionship, no skills are necessary.



They also installed emergency water tanks throughout Kapiti, sent tool boxes filled with donated surplus hand tools to the Solomon Islands and installed an automated external defibrillator unit for Community use.

The Shed is now doing something for itself. Formed in 2010 using a 42m² shed at the Kapiti Coast District Council works depot in Rangihiroa Street, Waikanae Beach the Kapiti Menzshed boasted ten members. Since then membership has grown to 40+, the shed to 240m² and now resource consent has been granted for further expansion.

Fundraising is already underway towards a \$180,000 development, which will provide a safer and
