The New Zealand **Radio Reading Service** has been operating from studios in Levin for more than 30 years, and is the only radio station in New Zealand to specifically assist people who are print disabled.

Broadcasts are not only accessed by the visually impaired, they are enjoyed by people with reading difficulties, whose first language is not English, with physical disabilities impairing their ability to read, and people whose location makes it

difficult to access the printed word. Of course some listeners simply enjoy being read to.

Programme content comes from local and national newspapers, recently published magazines and popular books. After New Zealand on Air removed all funding last year, paid employees lost their job but the majority chose to join the ranks of dedicated volunteers to keep the station running.
